We have been busy chefs in our preschool class!

Our fall project focus has been on cooking and baking. Utilizing our fine motor skills, experimenting with recipes, using kid-friendly knives to prepare tasty treats has been a thrill for our preschoolers. We especially enjoyed making pumpkin muffins and pizza! The most special thing we have discovered with cooking is being able to share our creations with others.

Spending extra time outdoors to explore what the season of fall brings has opened many new doors of creativity and inquiry. We discovered worms enjoy the moist soil that lives underneath the corn stalks in the field. We make shapes and artwork with acorns, pine cones, pieces of corn, pumpkins and leaves and use our big muscles to push large pumpkins up the hill.

Interacting with wildlife and different bugs has lead to a variety of intriguing conversations about life, why things function the way they do and provokes the wonder of God's beautiful creation.
