The majority of these campaign dollars will go toward **IN**creasing our classroom space so that more families will realize the benefits of education at Cross.

Construction includes:

- Expanded & updated school
- All classrooms located in one area of the building
- Comprehensive Early Learning Center with 6 preschool classrooms & 2 kindergarten classrooms
- 8 classrooms for grades 1 to 8
- Large common spaces for collaborative & innovative learning
- Dedicated children's ministry area
- Improved security
- Fully handicapped accessible

School Entrance / Welcome Lobby / Sending Spaces

All students will enter through current and new entrances to a safe and secure building. The completed plans create renovated space in our current west lobby for additional security, a parents' lounge, reception area, and sending spaces.

Early Learning Center

We will build eight classrooms and two large learning common areas on the first floor. The common areas will have a diversity of furniture and spaces to accommodate individual and group learning. Each classroom will have bathroom facilities and sinks. In addition, there will be a large-motor space/dining area.

Classroom and Learning Spaces



Dedicated Children's Ministry Space



Giving with IN tention



Every person or family can be a part of this important campaign. In some cases, it takes **IN** tentional effort to find funds to commit. God provides when we honor Him with our finances.

Here are some creative ways to increase your capacity for generosity:

- Gather your friends and neighbors to host a garage sale. Donate the proceeds to the campaign.
- Use your vehicle to make extra money by delivering pizza, food, or groceries. Or think about driving acquaintances to doctor appointments or the airport.
- Babysit or pet sit for family, friends, and neighbors.
- Do some extra cleaning for family or friends — car washing, window washing, garage clean-out, etc.
- Use your area of expertise and tutor local kids.
- Channel your inner creative side and put your skills to work.
 Photography and handmade items are always top sellers.
- Cut spending on food. Meal plan and shop once a week. Pack lunches for you and the kids.
- Brew your own coffee. You can save a ton of money by making coffee at home. Pause the daily coffee shop stop and put the extra cash to work for God's kingdom!

- Pause or cut entertainment subscriptions and memberships. Take some time to think about the stuff you don't even use, watch, or read.
- Plan creative dates that don't break the bank. You don't have to spend a lot of money to show a lot of love. Cut your date night spending by planning creative, budget-friendly dates like picnics, hikes, etc.


